The exhibition "Lawyers without rights" about Jewish lawyers in Germany during the Third Reich, was opened for the first time in 2009 in London, the Temple Church, by the Jewish Museum of London and the German Federal Bar.

The event tells the stories of fifteen German Jewish lawyers during the years of the Hitler regime, since 1933, when it was forbidden to sponsor at the Prussian court in 1938, the year in which he was prohibited practice of law in any form, and subsequent years have seen many lawyers Jews being deported to concentration camps and the most fortunate refuge abroad. Each story, despite the diversity of the outcome at times dramatic testimony to the commitment of these legal rights protection. Of those who found homes in the United Kingdom, some have contributed to the training and professional development of the British and the development of English law.

The CNF has wanted to re also in Italy this testimony, to contribute in this way to pierce the veil on the painful fracture experienced by the forensic world in the years of the fascist regime, including forensic institutions and the Italian Jewish community, including lawyers and Italian lawyers of Jewish religion. "The cancellation by the rolls of lawyers and attorneys of the Jewish religion is a painful historical events which must be subtracted to oblivion. The lawyers feel a particular sense of discomfort because the persecution was built with words and concepts of law ", she wrote the President Guido Alpa in the book " The racial laws and lawyers Italian- A look in the province"
